Bardia Jungle Safari Tour Overview

Bardia National Park is the largest national park and wilderness area in the Terai and has excellent wildlife-watching opportunities. Bardia is often described as what Chitwan was like 30 years ago, before

being overrun by tourism. The park protects 968 sq km of sal forest and grassland, and together with the new 550 sq km Banke National Park it protects one of Asia's largest stretches of tiger habitat. That's a lot of habitat, but even though tiger numbers are increasing after their recent demise during the Maoist insurgency, you'll still need exceptionally good luck to see one here.

There are also healthy populations of wild elephants and one-horned rhinos among the 30 species of mammals living here. Bardia also has more than 250 species of birds, including the endangered Bengal florican and sarus crane. Gharial and marsh mugger crocodiles and Gangetic dolphins are occasionally spotted on rafting and canoe trips along the Geruwa River, the eastern channel of the Karnali River.

5 Days Bardia Jungle Safari Tour Itinerary

Day 1: Fly to Nepalgunj from Kathmandu - Overnight in Nepalgunj

You will fly from Tribhuvan International Airport to Nepalgunj Domestic Airport. Upon your arrival at Nepalgunj Airport, our representatives will receive you and take you to the hotel, where you will spend the night. After reaching the hotel and refreshing yourselves, we encourage you to walk through the surrounding communities and try interacting with the locals. You also can visit the Bardia National Park visitor center and check out the crocodile breeding center.

Day 2: Full day jungle safari

Our representatives will give you a wake-up call in the morning and you will be served breakfast at the hotel itself. After having dinner, you start a walking journey towards the Bardia National Park. Today, you can expect a full-day jungle safari on a walk. Furthermore, you may also see different animals like one-horned rhinos and elephants. Besides, if lucky enough the walking safari also is a great chance to lay your eyes on the Bengal Tiger.

You will have a packed lunch in the afternoon as a picnic somewhere in the jungle and again go for a walk for a while. By the evening, you return to the lodge, where a tasty dinner waits for you. After having dinner, we recommend you take a deep rest because you will visit the jungle again the next day.

Today the dinner will be special because it will be the farewell dinner for our amazing travelers. After dinner, you can stay and talk about the overall experience, share contacts with new people you met, and also interact with the staff of the hotel.

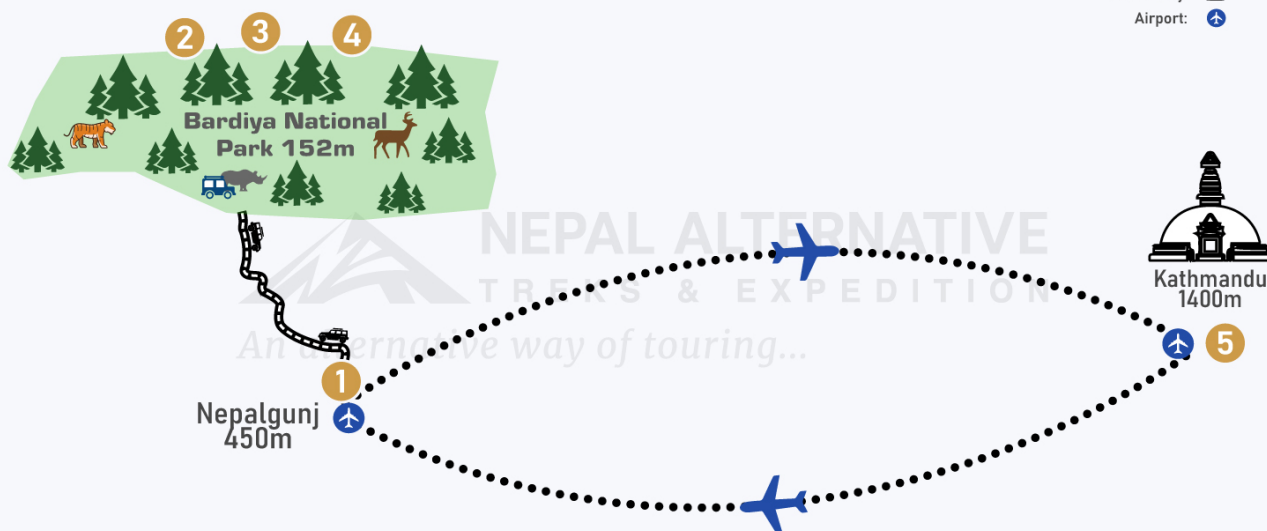
Bardia Jungle Safari Tour Route Map

Itinerary Highlight

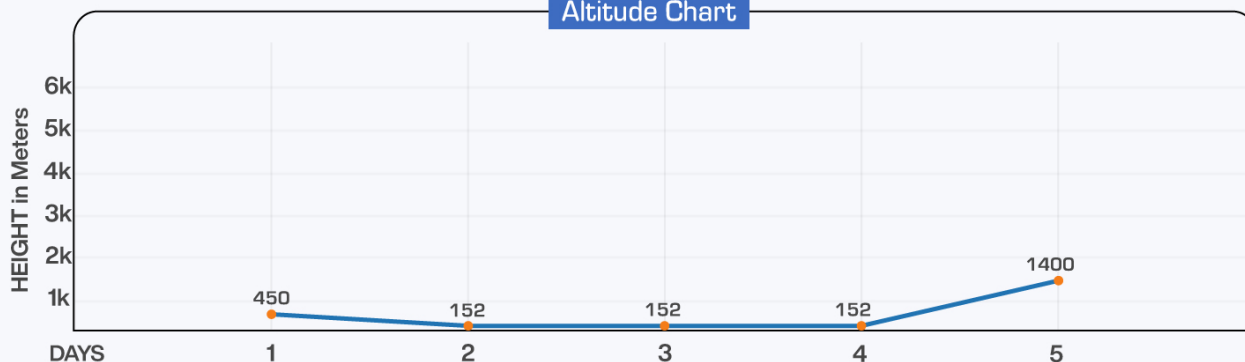

Additional Trip Information

Best time For Bardiya Jungle Safari

Bardia jungle safari tour is available throughout the year. But, the best time to visit the tour is in the Spring and Autumn seasons. Similarly, if you travel here you will be able to see the beauty of the place in a clear sky. Likewise, the beauty of this place will make your day. If you visit this place at this time of the year.

Is Bardia Jungle Safari Difficult?

This trip is not that difficult. You mostly travel through a vehicle. But, you should be careful with the wild animals. In addition, the heat can also affect your travel experience. If you decide to travel here during the summer season. In addition, you should be careful that you have every essential with you. Otherwise, this trek can be difficult for you.

Meals and Accommodation During Bardiya Jungle Safari

In the morning we provide coffee and during the trek, we provide you with some snacks. Similarly, hotels and lodges are also available. So that you can fully enjoy yourself. Similarly, we understand that your diet is important for the trek. So, the meals are perfect for you on your tour.

Transportation Facility During Bardiya Jungle Safari

We provide you with a jeep safari on the 2nd and 3rd day of the tour. But, you sometimes have to walk to certain places. Similarly, the transportation facility we provide is reliable and trustworthy. Likewise, the transportation we provide is high quality. So, don't worry about the transportation facility.

Tour availability

Mostly the tour is available throughout the year but, programs and timings vary somewhat according to change in season and are also subject to change in case of unforeseen circumstances. So, make sure that you check the timing correctly.

Tour Duration

The tour lasts for four days. Where you will be able to see different animals and birds. Also, have a lifetime experience. Similarly, make sure you have all the important things with you for the entire time of the tour.

Frequently Asked Questions

Is Bardia National Park safe for tourists?

Yes, Bardia National Park is safe for tourists. This area has not been affected by the earthquake in 2015. Also, there is no burst of epidemics or viral diseases or covid-19 . The country is politically stable. However, sudden non-violent protests and occasional strikes are frequent. They usually do not have much impact on tourists, but it is better to avoid leaving hotels on such days. We also recommend you keep yourself updated with the local news.

The government and other respective bodies are continuously are trying to facilitate accessible communication, comfortable and safe internal travel, proper healthcare facility, and services of accommodation in different tourist destinations for tourists.

When is the best season for this tour ?

The best season to visit Bardia National Park is during autumn (September to November) as the weather is stable, dry, and clear. Also, the atmosphere is merry during these seasons, as autumn is the major festive season of the country. Another favorable season for trekking is during spring (March to May) as the trails become more vibrant and pleasing with the blooming of different wildflowers, Flora and Fauna. The days are clear and perfect for a tour.

December to February is the coldest time of the year. From June to August, the region experiences the summer season. Humidity increases along with the temperature. Hence, the monsoon starts, which makes the skies cloudy, and the roads muddy and slippery. There are chances of flooding and landslides throughout the country as well.

Do you have other dates available that match my timing?

Even though our tour packages have pre-fixed group departure dates, we can tailor them to accommodate your specific requests and schedule. Please review our designated departure dates, and if they do not suit your timeframe, let us know your preferred timing so that we can manage your itinerary accordingly. We organize this tour as per your wishes and convenience. Normally, we have a regular fixed group departure for this tour. so, you can join any date even if you are a single traveler.

As a single trekker, may I join this fixed departure Tour package? Will it be possible to get a separate room?

Our group packages are designed in such a way that they suit single travelers too. It is a great way to get to know new people with similar interests, and most people find that group dynamics are very friendly and comforting. Single trekkers will share accommodation with other individual travelers of the same gender on our group journeys.

If you are a single traveler wishing for a private room, we can manage that as well, but you will have to inform us about it while booking the trip. Also, please note that you may have to pay some additional charges for single rooms.

Can we change money in Bardia National Park ? Can we pay by credit card or foreign currency ?

No, You should take Nepali rupees with you. You can pay your bill with credit cards and foreign currency that are accepted by Nepal Rastra Bank but we recommend you to pay the bill in Nepali rupees in cash.

What kind of food will be provided during Bardia national park tour ?

Our package includes three meals per day, breakfast, lunch, and dinner. Dinner and lunch include the authentic Nepali Daal-Bhat (rice and lentils) along with seasonal vegetables, spinach, and pickle in a buffet system.

We serve different tests as Asian, Continental food, and even pizzas. The food is prepared hygienically.

What are the documents that we need to bring for this tour ?

You need to submit the following documents that should be sent via email :

What are the accommodation arrangements during tour ?

In this tour, the accommodation options are deluxe resorts to budget homestays. Nepal Alternative Treks generally manages your accommodation fully furnished, air-conditioned, clean, and well-located resort that provides single, double rooms and triple bedrooms. The bed has a mattress, pillow, and blanket with a bathroom inside.

Are alcoholic beverages available in Bardia National Park ?

You can easily find different types of alcoholic beverages of international as well as Nepalese brands. In a local village nearby, you can either find local (home-made) drinks like Chyang, Raksi, and Tongba or other packaged drinks of Nepalese brands.

Is it possible to communicate with friends and family back home while on tour ?

There are mobile networks, internet data, and Wi-Fi available in Bardia National Park and entire route, and you can connect to your friends and family back home.

For mobile network and internet data, you will require a Nepalese SIM-Card. If you wish to buy a Nepalese SIM-Card, we will assist you in getting it. You can buy a SIM-Card from local distributors easily with some fees. We recommend **Namaste** SIM to have better network coverage and 4G data uses.

What is the weather and temperature like we can expect during the tour ?

The temperature could range around and above 35 degrees Celsius in summers and decrease below -5 degrees Celsius in winters. During autumn and spring, temperature ranges around 10 to 20 degrees Celsius, making it suitable for Jungle safari tour purposes.

Cancellation Policy

We understand that plans can change willy-nilly. However it is our responsibility to ensure fairness and transparency among our customers regarding our cancellation policy. So we kindly request all travelers to carefully review the cancellation and refund policy before confirming their trip.

After your trip starts, we cannot provide a refund for any voluntary withdrawal, cancellation, or early departure by the traveler. This means ***the full amount paid to us will not be refunded after the trip has begun.*** Likewise, if during the trip, any services such as accommodation, sightseeing, meals, transportation, etc. included in the itinerary/trip are not used by the customer, no refunds or reuse will be provided to whatever portion remains unused on the trip.

Also, please note that ***last-minute cancellations are non-refundable.*** You have to understand that many trip arrangements such as accommodation, transportation, permits, guides, and operational logistics are confirmed and pre-booked. Thus, cancellations made at the last minute create non-recoverable costs for the company and so do for our clients. In addition, cancellations made shortly before the departure date or after the trip has started will be considered as last-minute cancellations and will not be eligible for any refund.

Still, the company will use their discretion in setting the conditions for the refunds, therefore, few of the conditions mentioned are subject to change. The company holds every right to cancel the trips booked by the customers before it is guaranteed to run or an official agreement is signed. A trip is guaranteed to run once it has two fully paid travelers unless minimum numbers state otherwise.

Unfortunate circumstances such as unforeseen natural disaster, canceled flights, strike, industrial action, wars, riots, quarantine, government intervention, weather, the deteriorating health condition of a group member, etc. could lead to cancellation of trips. In such cases, the customer can either ask to get back the 90% of the total trip cost paid to the company (13% Government Tax will be deducted) or reuse the cost in an alternative trip with the same price, immediately, in the following season of the same year.

The company will require a written notice in case of any cancellation. Please ensure the date of the trip cancellation is the date on which the written cancellation is received by the company. If you cancel the trip anytime prior to the departure date of the actual trip, 90% of the total cost is reusable for a year or refund.

Trip Amendment

First and foremost, please note that all the amendment conditions are applied to the trips listed on this site only. Below are a few notes to take about the amendment fees in case of any changes during, while, or after the booking:

If the company receives a request on the booking amendments at least 60 days prior to the trip, a total of USD 50/person is charged to the customer. However, if the customer's request for a booking amendment in less than 60 days before the trip departure, then the charges will be as per the cancellation policy mentioned above. In case of any changes in the price of the trip during the procedure of booking and the amendments, the new cost will be applied to the trips. Please note that these changes might not be applied by the company, but can be levied upon the company by the third parties i.e. the hotels or the service providers working with the company.

Any changes, amendments, or additions in aggregation to the trips you have booked, for example, hotels, transfers, additional days, etc. will account for no additional fee.

Health Conditions

Nepal Alternative Treks places the highest priority on the safety and well-being of all travelers. We need to ensure the traveler's well-being and health condition at the time of booking. While travelers can participate without medical documentation, those with chronic illnesses or long-term medical conditions must obtain a doctor's consent before joining the trip. This is to ensure their health is not badly affected during the adventure and that they can safely enjoy the journey.

The company will not be responsible for any type of mishaps and will not bear the medical and evacuation expenses on behalf of the participant. Therefore, we request our clients to consult their doctors for a thorough checkup and vaccination before booking a trip with us. In addition, clients with specific health needs or concerns should inform the Company in advance. This allows us to provide guidance and, if required, arrange additional services to make the trip safer and more comfortable. If needed, clients may also request additional services related to the length of the trip or stay in the country of travel.

Weather and other unfavorable conditions

Clients should be well aware of the unpredictability of the weather conditions in the mountainous regions. The unfortunate weather conditions, especially in the Everest, Jomsom, and Kanchenjunga regions, can sometimes lead to unfavorable circumstances that include delay or cancellation of flights. The Company will cover the expenses of accommodations and food in the departing location until the arrangement of flights is done. However, the Company holds every right to reroute the original trip or transports which will be in favor of the situation without any addition in the cost. Please note that the company will not be responsible for any missed international flights, losses caused by Altitude Sickness, or any other unpredictable circumstances, and the participants will have to pay all the charges incurred. Nonetheless, the Company will connect and assist you to make the necessary alternative arrangements, but, the additional charge will be covered by the customers themselves.

Regardless of stating every condition and information about the trips on the website and brochures of the Company, we will not be responsible for the unforeseeable situations that may arise before or during the trips. The Company will, however, try its level best to give prior notice about it and take alternate strategies to deal with it. These booking conditions may only be waived in special circumstances, and in writing, by a letter from the Chief of the Company. Note that all the legal agreements set up and signed between the client and the Company shall be subjected to and governed by the Nepalese law.

Note: All the Terms and Conditions mentioned are prepared as per the laws of the Government of Nepal and is governed by them. Therefore, only the head of the Company gets to intervene and holds the authority to make any amendments.

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
