Chandragiri Chitlang Hiking Overview

Chandragiri Chitlang Hiking is a new and short hiking destination from Kathmandu. Many trekkers, even locals, are confused that you must go far and wide for a good hiking spot; however, a Ghitalng hike will make that theory false. It is one of the rapidly growing hiking trails that is a **short distance** from Kathmandu and will give you a true adventure in nature. Previously, not many people were able to visit Chandragiri Hill and Chitland due to the lack of proper roads and transportation, a problem that has been solved recently.

Thanks to the **installation of cable cars**, Chandragiri Hill has recently developed into an intriguing tourist destination. Chitlang, a historic Newari town in the Makwanpur area, is the next destination on the trip. A fascinating draw is provided by the various aesthetic structures, pagoda roofs, and superb craftsmanship seen throughout the area. On the second day, we continued hiking in Kulekhani.

Moreover, Chandragiri unveiled an outstanding cable car system. The gondolas travel between the steep crevasses of the hill in between broad screens on all sides, making for an exhilarating journey. You can use the cable car or go on a lengthy downhill hike.

An alternative route to Chandragiri

This recommended path begins from Machhegaun, Chandragiri Hill's base, and ends at the peak. It can take up to three hours to complete. To enjoy the best views of the mountain range and the valley, it is advisable to begin the hike early in the day.

The trail meanders into the lush woodland once you leave the residential village in your rearview mirror. You ascend the hill fast by taking a zigzag path while the valley below narrows. Hikers are greeted by magnificent views of the valley below all along the forest trek. When you reach the summit, the mountain ranges are renowned for playing hide and seek with you when the skies open up for breathtaking views.

Bhaleshwor Mahadev Temple, which has been rebuilt, is atop the mountain. Hindu believers think the temple can grant visitors' wishes. A recently built park with a restaurant and a viewing tower surrounds the temple. The viewing tower offers a clear 360-degree view of the surrounding area, including views of the high hills between the valley and Mount Everest in the east and Mount Dhaulagiri in the west.

Best Time for Chandragiri Chitlang Hike

The Chandragiri Chitlang Hike is one of those fantastic hikes to explore all year round. However, certain times make exploring even more fun. The best time for Chitlang Hike can be divided into seasons, so let's get into this.

October

October is the best month for Chandragiri Chitlang Hike. Since this month lies in the peak **Autumn season, there is no rain, the weather is fantastic, and the temperature is mild.** Furthermore, you will also have clear views of the mountains and the sky. Nepal celebrates some unique festivals in October, so the hike to Chandragiri can be even more special.

April

Apart from October, April is another good month for Chandragiri Chitlang Hiking. After the winter season in Nepal, Spring brings amazing weather, climate, temperature, and atmosphere for trekking. During the peak Spring seasons, you will be joined by fantastic flowering trails throughout the hills, where you will see different kinds of flowers and forests blooming.

Difficulty

Chandragiri Chitlang Hiking Difficulty

The Chandragiri Chitlang hike is relatively easy near Kathmandu Valley. First, you will drive from Kathmandu to Chandragiri for about two to three hours, which won't be too difficult. Upon reaching Chandragiri, your trek to Chitlang starts as you hike towards hilly trails that are also not very difficult to scale.

The hike from Chandragiri to Chitlang is about five hours long along the trails of low-altitude subtropical forests and vegetation. The trail is relatively flat and mostly downside, meaning it will be easier to scale. The hike to Chandragiri also does not pass through remote settlements, so you will find all the services during your hike till you reach Chitlang. Furthermore, the altitude of Chitlang is just over 1800m, so there is no chance of altitude sickness for trekkers.

2 Days Chandragiri Chitlang Hike Itinerary

Day 1: Drive to Matatirtha - Hike to Chandragiri Hills - Hike to Chitlang

The trip to Matatirtha, where the hike starts, takes around 35 minutes. "Matatirtha" refers to the mother's shrine. During Mother's Day in April each year (the Hindu people of Nepal commemorate Mother's Day on the new moon day), this shrine receives many visitors/pilgrims who have lost their

mothers. After installing a cable car, the old **Chandragiri Hills Top temple site (2729m)** has recently become a new, well-liked tourist destination.

The region is covered with lush subtropical forest with a variety of flora and wildlife, which gives the area a lot of natural greenery. ***It takes 4-5 hours to climb over several smaller hills***, a lush jungle, and a tiny village before arriving at Chhap Bhanjyang (you might be lucky to find a local cafe to enjoy a cup of soothing tea or coffee here). Chandragiri Hill has an attractive park, eateries, and the Bhaleshwor Mahadev Temple. On a clear day, the majestic mountain ranges of Mt. Gaurishanker, Dorje Lakpa, Langtang, Manaslu, Ganesh Himal, Makalu, Mt. Everest, Api, etc. may be seen from east to west.

We eat lunch while admiring Chandragiri Hills' natural splendor and the Himalayas, then climb back down to Chitlang. The old settlement of Chitlang is still home to numerous artfully constructed rest homes, stone water taps, and other artifacts that attest to its former status as a civilized community. **There are a few lodges where you can stay**, and Chitlang Village also offers homestays where you can connect and learn about rural life in Nepal. When visiting Chitlang,

Historical attractions like **Pauwa, Saat Dhara (seven water taps)**, Shiwalaya, and other ancient monuments will increase your enjoyment.

Day 2: Hike to Kulekhani via Markhu Village - Drive to Kathmandu

After a delicious breakfast, continue your hike. We arrive at **Kulekhani after a hike of roughly one and a half hours. The largest man-made lake (dam) in Nepal** is located in Khulekhani, which was built to generate hydroelectricity. Indrasarovar Lake is its name (Sarovar Means Lake). We can take pleasure in lake boating. We then take a journey back to Kathmandu after lunch. We travel past the Black Goddess of the South, **Dakshinkali Temple**, and the well-known Buddhist pilgrimage site of Pharping, where the illustrious ***Guru Padmasambhava is reputed to have meditated and gained Buddhahood***. If we'd like, we can use this chance to explore the temple and monastery. Drive back to Kathmandu as usual.

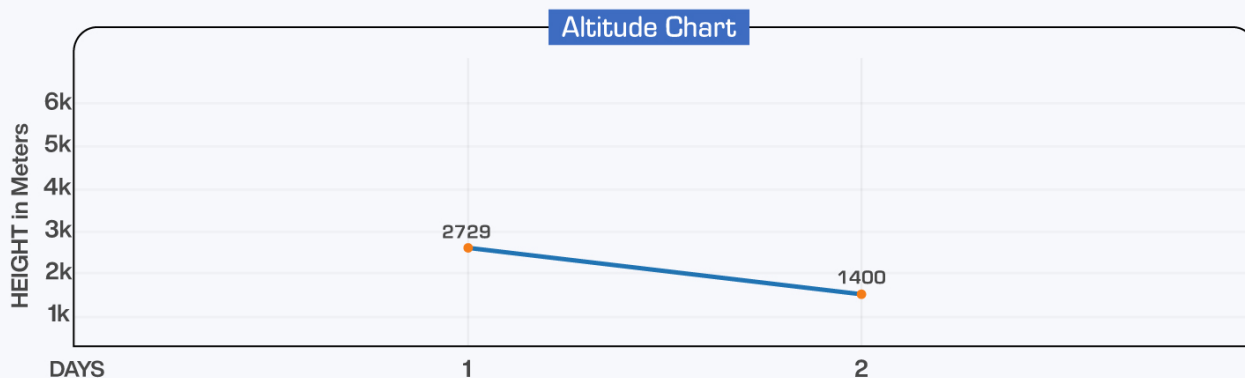

Alternative Route of Chandragiri Chitlang Hiking

The Chandragiri Chitlang Hiking alternative route starts at Machhegaun, the base of Chandragiri Hill, and ends at the peak. **The hike can take up to three hours**, so it's best to start early in the day to

enjoy the beautiful views of the mountain range and the valley.

Once you leave the village, the trail goes through lush woodland. The path ascends the hill quickly in a zigzag pattern, offering great views of the narrow valley below. Along the forest trek, hikers can enjoy magnificent views of the valley. ***When you reach the summit, you'll be treated to stunning views of the mountain ranges when the skies clear up.***

Bhaleshwor Mahadev Temple, which has been rebuilt, is atop the mountain. **Hindu believers think the temple can grant visitors' wishes.** A recently built park with a restaurant and a viewing tower surrounds the temple. The viewing tower offers a clear 360-degree view of the surrounding area, including views of the high hills between the valley and Mount Everest in the east and Mount Dhaulagiri in the west.

Chandragiri Hills

Chitlang Village

Indrasarovar is also an ideal place to take a break, have lunch, and take lovely pictures. **It is also a perfect place for fishing and boating**, and it has been attracting many tourists for a few years.

Frequently Asked Questions

How long is Chandragiri Chitlang Hike?

Chandragiri, one of the numerous hills around the Kathmandu Valley, has long been a popular pilgrimage site for Nepalis. It provides one of Kathmandu's excellent vantage points of the Himalayan range at a height of 2,551 meters.

Is Chandragiri worth visiting?

Bringing a coat up the mountain is a good idea because the vista is stunning, and there is a significant temperature difference at the base. The Hindu temples above are stunning, and the air is immaculate. Take a trip with the cable car.

How long is Chandragiri's cable car ride?

The 2.5 km long cable car gives you a close-up view of the pristine forest while ensuring smooth and safe travel. Using a 2.5-kilometer cable car trip, it takes 9 minutes to get to the top station of the Chandragiri Hills.

Can you see Everest from Chandragiri?

Chandragiri highlands provide a clear view of Everest's summit as well as other summits like Cho Oyu, Gaurisankhar, and Kang Nachugo.

Who is the owner of Chandragiri Hills?

Dhakal founded Chandragiri Hills and served as its founding chairman. Chairman Dhakal claimed that since 2009, he has considered Chandragiri Hills an integrated tourism infrastructure, influenced by the Genting Highlands project constructed there during his extended visit to Malaysia.

What is Chitlang famous for?

Before the Tribhuvan Highway was created, the Chitlang historic commercial route connected Kathmandu with the rest of the nation. Since then, Chitlang has recovered and is a popular tourist destination.

What is the best time to visit Chitlang?

Whether winter, summer, or spring, Chitlang is a great site to visit. One can camp in Chitlang's lush vegetation in the summer, while in the winter, one can stay in a private homestay. The flowers blossom throughout the springtime months of March and April, giving tourists a tranquil experience.

How far is Chitlang from KTM?

Concerning Chitlang. Chitlang is located 195.3 kilometers from Pokhara and 28 km from Kathmandu. In the South Asian landlocked nation of Nepal's Narayani Zone sits the village of Chitlang.

What is the altitude of Chitlang, Nepal?

An old Newar settlement is called Chitlang. It is a tiny village around 22 kilometers south of Kathmandu. This settlement, 1833 meters above sea level, is south of Chandragiri Hill.

Which fruit is Chitlang famous for?

A Pear Orchard that attracts tens of thousands of visitors serves as Chitlang's main draw. The Chitlang village dates back to the Lichchhavi dynasty and served as a commerce route between Tibet and India.

What is the famous product of Chitlang?

The famous product of Chitlang that foreign trekkers and local people love is goat cheese. Ashok Singh Thakuri, the owner of the local teahouse, is quite renowned for teaching trekkers the process of goat cheese and even providing them with cheese delicacies like ice creams.

Which months are not ideal for Chandragiri Chitlang Hiking?

When it rains most, the least ideal time for Chandragiri Chitlang Hiking is June, July, and August. As the hikers must flee from hills and valleys, avoiding the rainy seasons is wise.

When was Chandragiri Cable Car opened to the public?

Chandragiri Cable Car was opened to the public in 2016. It takes passengers from Thankot to Chandragiri Hills and is among Nepal's famous trekking or tourist hubs.

When was Chandragiri Hill Resort established?

The Chandragiri Hill Resort was established around late 2016, but no date was confirmed. However, the resort was established to provide services for people who take cable cars to reach Chandragiri Hills.

Do we need to carry extra money for Chandragiri Chitlang Hiking?

It is wise to carry extra money during your hiking as you may want to spend additional money on shopping or tips, but most expenses are covered in the itinerary.

Cancellation Policy

We understand that plans can change willy-nilly. However it is our responsibility to ensure fairness and transparency among our customers regarding our cancellation policy. So we kindly request all travelers to carefully review the cancellation and refund policy before confirming their trip.

After your trip starts, we cannot provide a refund for any voluntary withdrawal, cancellation, or early departure by the traveler. This means ***the full amount paid to us will not be refunded after the trip has begun***. Likewise, if during the trip, any services such as accommodation, sightseeing, meals, transportation, etc. included in the itinerary/trip are not used by the customer, no refunds or reuse will be provided to whatever portion remains unused on the trip.

Also, please note that ***last-minute cancellations are non-refundable***. You have to understand that many trip arrangements such as accommodation, transportation, permits, guides, and operational logistics are confirmed and pre-booked. Thus, cancellations made at the last minute create non-recoverable costs for the company and so do for our clients. In addition, cancellations made shortly before the departure date or after the trip has started will be considered as last-minute cancellations and will not be eligible for any refund.

Still, the company will use their discretion in setting the conditions for the refunds, therefore, few of the conditions mentioned are subject to change. The company holds every right to cancel the trips booked by

the customers before it is guaranteed to run or an official agreement is signed. A trip is guaranteed to run once it has two fully paid travelers unless minimum numbers state otherwise.

Unfortunate circumstances such as unforeseen natural disaster, canceled flights, strike, industrial action, wars, riots, quarantine, government intervention, weather, the deteriorating health condition of a group member, etc. could lead to cancellation of trips. In such cases, the customer can either ask to get back the 90% of the total trip cost paid to the company (13% Government Tax will be deducted) or reuse the cost in an alternative trip with the same price, immediately, in the following season of the same year.

The company will require a written notice in case of any cancellation. Please ensure the date of the trip cancellation is the date on which the written cancellation is received by the company. If you cancel the trip anytime prior to the departure date of the actual trip, 90% of the total cost is reusable for a year or refund.

Trip Amendment

First and foremost, please note that all the amendment conditions are applied to the trips listed on this site only. Below are a few notes to take about the amendment fees in case of any changes during, while, or after the booking:

If the company receives a request on the booking amendments at least 60 days prior to the trip, a total of USD 50/person is charged to the customer. However, if the customer's request for a booking amendment in less than 60 days before the trip departure, then the charges will be as per the cancellation policy mentioned above. In case of any changes in the price of the trip during the procedure of booking and the amendments, the new cost will be applied to the trips. Please note that these changes might not be applied by the company, but can be levied upon the company by the third parties i.e. the hotels or the service providers working with the company.

Any changes, amendments, or additions in aggregation to the trips you have booked, for example, hotels, transfers, additional days, etc. will account for no additional fee.

Health Conditions

Nepal Alternative Treks places the highest priority on the safety and well-being of all travelers. We need to ensure the traveler's well-being and health condition at the time of booking. While travelers can participate without medical documentation, those with chronic illnesses or long-term medical conditions must obtain a doctor's consent before joining the trip. This is to ensure their health is not badly affected during the adventure and that they can safely enjoy the journey.

The company will not be responsible for any type of mishaps and will not bear the medical and evacuation expenses on behalf of the participant. Therefore, we request our clients to consult their doctors for a thorough checkup and vaccination before booking a trip with us. In addition, clients with specific health needs or concerns should inform the Company in advance. This allows us to provide guidance and, if required, arrange additional services to make the trip safer and more comfortable. If needed, clients may also request additional services related to the length of the trip or stay in the country of travel.

Weather and other unfavorable conditions

Clients should be well aware of the unpredictability of the weather conditions in the mountainous regions. The unfortunate weather conditions, especially in the Everest, Jomsom, and Kanchenjunga regions, can sometimes lead to unfavorable circumstances that include delay or cancellation of flights. The Company will cover the expenses of accommodations and food in the departing location until the arrangement of flights is done. However, the Company holds every right to reroute the original trip or transports which will be in favor of the situation without any addition in the cost. Please note that the company will not be responsible for any missed international flights, losses caused by Altitude Sickness, or any other unpredictable circumstances, and the participants will have to pay all the charges incurred. Nonetheless, the Company will connect and assist you to make the necessary alternative arrangements, but, the additional charge will be covered by the customers themselves.

Regardless of stating every condition and information about the trips on the website and brochures of the Company, we will not be responsible for the unforeseeable situations that may arise before or during the trips. The Company will, however, try its level best to give prior notice about it and take alternate strategies to deal with it. These booking conditions may only be waived in special circumstances, and in writing, by a letter from the Chief of the Company. Note that all the legal agreements set up and signed between the client and the Company shall be subjected to and governed by the Nepalese law.

Note: All the Terms and Conditions mentioned are prepared as per the laws of the Government of Nepal and is governed by them. Therefore, only the head of the Company gets to intervene and holds the authority to make any amendments.

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
