Chitwan Jungle Safari Tour Overview

Another way you can experience this wild world is by 4 wheel drive jeep. By jeep or elephant back, you can go deep into the heart of the park, viewing some of the rare species of flora and fauna. You can also go on foot in to the park escorted by our well-trained naturalist who will interpret to you the concealed secrets of the jungle. You will have a great opportunity to see many species of birds including water fowl, Brahminy ducks, pintails, bar-headed geese, cormorants, woodpeckers, hornbills, peacocks, peahens, florescent, red-headed trogons and many others.

Another activity in the park is the boat/canoe trip down the Rapti and the Narayani Rivers. This is one of the more serene ways to explore the area as float downstream with the river's flow. On the out skirts of Chitwan you can the Tharu community, and see their artistically decorated thatched huts, their typical dance and how they manage life next to the national park. A Chitwan jungle safari is certainly an adventure that the whole family can enjoy.

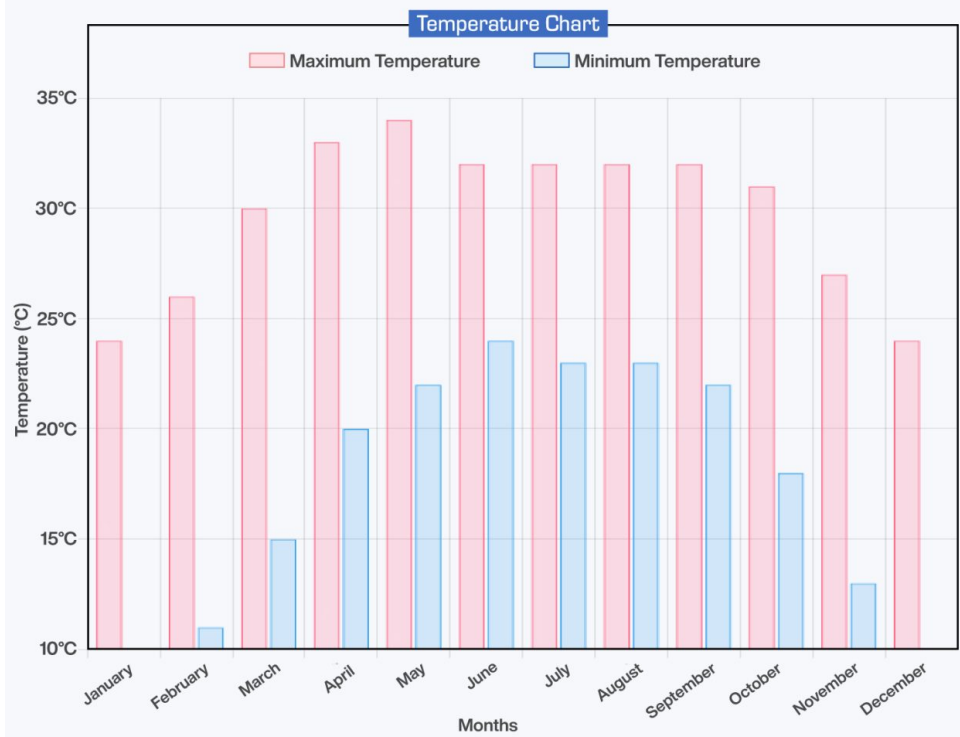
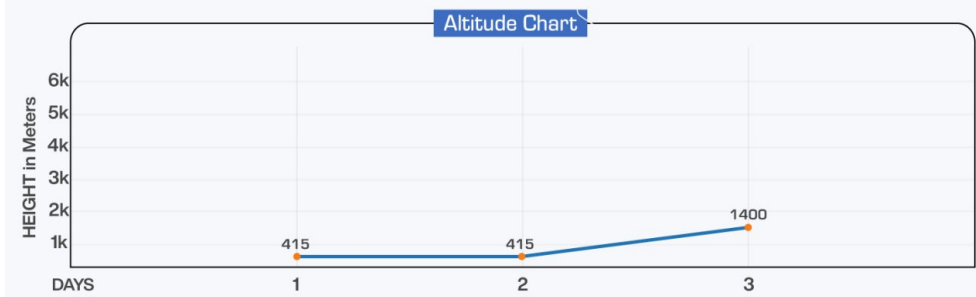

Additional Trip Information

Best time For Chitwan Jungle Safari

Chitwan jungle is mostly available throughout the year. But, the best time to visit this place is during March, April, and May in the Spring season and September, October, and November in Autumn.

Chitwan Jungle Safari Difficulty Level

This trip is not that difficult. It is a very easy trip. Mostly, you travel by jeep during the trip. But, in some places, you have to walk and that can be difficult. Similarly, you can face some wild animals. Likewise, during the tour, if you decide to do it during the summer then the temperature can get a little high around 40 degrees at max. In addition, in the summer season, as the temperature rises, make sure you drink a lot of water. Because during the summer season the climate of Chitwan rises.

Meals and accommodation During Chitwan Jungle Safari

All Meals while safari includes breakfast, lunch, and dinner with tea/coffee three times a day. Similarly, all the accommodation is added in a/c.

Transportation

The transportation here is done through a bus from Kathmandu to Chitwan. Other than that we don't provide any transportation facility. We will walk and rest in lodges during the trek.

Tour availability

The tour is mostly available throughout the year. But, it can vary from season to season. Annually, a lot of tourists visit this place throughout the year.

Tour duration

The tour lasts for three days. During this time, you will be able to see various animals and birds. This time of the year you will never forget for your entire life.

Frequently Asked Questions

Is this Chitwan National Park safe for tourists?

Yes, Chitwan National Park is safe for tourists. This area has not been affected by the earthquake in 2015. Also, there is no burst of epidemics or viral diseases or covid-19 . The country is politically stable. However, sudden non-violent protests and occasional strikes are frequent. They usually do not have much impact on tourists, but it is better to avoid leaving hotels on such days. We also recommend you keep yourself updated with the local news.

The government and other respective bodies are continuously are trying to facilitate accessible communication, comfortable and safe internal travel, proper healthcare facility, and services of accommodation in different tourist destinations for tourists.

When is the best season for this tour ?

The best season to visit Chitwan National Park is during autumn (September to November) as the weather is stable, dry, and clear. Also, the atmosphere is merry during these seasons, as autumn is the major festive season of the country. Another favorable season for trekking is during spring (March to May) as the trails become more vibrant and pleasing with the blooming of different wildflowers, Flora and Fauna. The days are clear and perfect for a tour.

December to February is the coldest time of the year. From June to August, the region experiences the summer season. Humidity increases along with the temperature. Hence, the monsoon starts, which makes the skies cloudy, and the roads muddy and slippery. There are chances of flooding and landslides throughout the country as well.

Do you have other dates available that match my timing?

Even though our tour packages have pre-fixed group departure dates, we can tailor them to accommodate your specific requests and schedule. Please review our designated departure dates, and if

they do not suit your timeframe, let us know your preferred timing so that we can manage your itinerary accordingly. We organize this tour as per your wishes and convenience. Normally, we have a regular fixed group departure for this tour. so, you can join any date even if you are a single traveler.

As a single trekker, may I join this fixed departure Tour package? Will it be possible to get a separate room?

Our group packages are designed in such a way that they suit single travelers too. It is a great way to get to know new people with similar interests, and most people find that group dynamics are very friendly and comforting. Single trekkers will share accommodation with other individual trekkers of the same gender on our group journeys.

If you are a single traveler wishing for a private room, we can manage that as well, but you will have to inform us about it while booking the trip. Also, please note that you may have to pay some additional charges for single rooms.

Can we change money in Chitwan National Park ? Can we pay by credit card or foreign currency ?

Yes, there are plenty of money exchanges at Saurah. You can also pay your bill with credit cards and foreign currency that are accepted by Nepal Rastra Bank but we recommend you to pay the bill in Nepali rupees.

What kind of food will be provided during this tour ?

Our package includes three meals per day, breakfast, lunch, and dinner. Dinner and lunch include the authentic Nepali Daal-Bhat (rice and lentils) along with seasonal vegetables, spinach, and pickle in a buffet system.

We serve different tests as Asian, Continental food, and even pizzas. The food is prepared hygienically.

What are the documents that we need to bring for this tour ?

You need to submit the following documents that should be sent via email :

- A copy of passport,
- Flight details,

What are the accommodation arrangements during the tour ?

In this tour, the accommodation options are 4-star resorts to budget homestays. Nepal Alternative Treks generally manages your accommodation fully furnished, air-conditioned, clean, and well-located resort that provides single or double rooms and triple bedrooms. The bed has a mattress, pillow, and blanket.

Are alcoholic beverages available in Chitwan National Park ?

You can easily find different types of alcoholic beverages of international as well as Nepalese brands. In Tharu villages, however, you can either find local (home-made) drinks like Chyang, Raksi, and Tongba or other packaged drinks of Nepalese brands.

Is it possible to communicate with friends and family back home while on tour ?

There are mobile networks, internet data, and Wi-Fi available in Chitwan National Park and entire route, and you can connect to your friends and family back home.

For mobile network and internet data, you will require a Nepalese SIM-Card. If you wish to buy a Nepalese SIM-Card, we will assist you in getting it. You can buy a SIM-Card from local distributors easily with some fees. We recommend **Namaste** SIM to have better network coverage and 4G data uses.

What is the weather and temperature like we can expect during the tour ?

The temperature could range around and above 35 degrees Celsius in summers and decrease below -5 degrees Celsius in winters. During autumn and spring, temperature ranges around 10 to 20 degrees Celsius, making it suitable for Jungle safari tour purposes.

Cancellation Policy

We understand that plans can change willy-nilly. However it is our responsibility to ensure fairness and transparency among our customers regarding our cancellation policy. So we kindly request all travelers to carefully review the cancellation and refund policy before confirming their trip.

After your trip starts, we cannot provide a refund for any voluntary withdrawal, cancellation, or early departure by the traveler. This means ***the full amount paid to us will not be refunded after the trip has begun.*** Likewise, if during the trip, any services such as accommodation, sightseeing, meals, transportation, etc. included in the itinerary/trip are not used by the customer, no refunds or reuse will be provided to whatever portion remains unused on the trip.

Also, please note that ***last-minute cancellations are non-refundable.*** You have to understand that many trip arrangements such as accommodation, transportation, permits, guides, and operational logistics are confirmed and pre-booked. Thus, cancellations made at the last minute create non-recoverable costs for the company and so do for our clients. In addition, cancellations made shortly before the departure date or after the trip has started will be considered as last-minute cancellations and will not be eligible for any refund.

Still, the company will use their discretion in setting the conditions for the refunds, therefore, few of the conditions mentioned are subject to change. The company holds every right to cancel the trips booked by the customers before it is guaranteed to run or an official agreement is signed. A trip is guaranteed to run once it has two fully paid travelers unless minimum numbers state otherwise.

Unfortunate circumstances such as unforeseen natural disaster, canceled flights, strike, industrial action, wars, riots, quarantine, government intervention, weather, the deteriorating health condition of a group member, etc. could lead to cancellation of trips. In such cases, the customer can either ask to get back the 90% of the total trip cost paid to the company (13% Government Tax will be deducted) or reuse the cost in an alternative trip with the same price, immediately, in the following season of the same year.

The company will require a written notice in case of any cancellation. Please ensure the date of the trip cancellation is the date on which the written cancellation is received by the company. If you cancel the

trip anytime prior to the departure date of the actual trip, 90% of the total cost is reusable for a year or refund.

Trip Amendment

First and foremost, please note that all the amendment conditions are applied to the trips listed on this site only. Below are a few notes to take about the amendment fees in case of any changes during, while, or after the booking:

If the company receives a request on the booking amendments at least 60 days prior to the trip, a total of USD 50/person is charged to the customer. However, if the customer's request for a booking amendment in less than 60 days before the trip departure, then the charges will be as per the cancellation policy mentioned above. In case of any changes in the price of the trip during the procedure of booking and the amendments, the new cost will be applied to the trips. Please note that these changes might not be applied by the company, but can be levied upon the company by the third parties i.e. the hotels or the service providers working with the company.

Any changes, amendments, or additions in aggregation to the trips you have booked, for example, hotels, transfers, additional days, etc. will account for no additional fee.

Health Conditions

Nepal Alternative Treks places the highest priority on the safety and well-being of all travelers. We need to ensure the traveler's well-being and health condition at the time of booking. While travelers can participate without medical documentation, those with chronic illnesses or long-term medical conditions must obtain a doctor's consent before joining the trip. This is to ensure their health is not badly affected during the adventure and that they can safely enjoy the journey.

The company will not be responsible for any type of mishaps and will not bear the medical and evacuation expenses on behalf of the participant. Therefore, we request our clients to consult their doctors for a thorough checkup and vaccination before booking a trip with us. In addition, clients with specific health needs or concerns should inform the Company in advance. This allows us to provide guidance and, if required, arrange additional services to make the trip safer and more comfortable. If needed, clients may also request additional services related to the length of the trip or stay in the country of travel.

Weather and other unfavorable conditions

Clients should be well aware of the unpredictability of the weather conditions in the mountainous regions. The unfortunate weather conditions, especially in the Everest, Jomsom, and Kanchenjunga regions, can sometimes lead to unfavorable circumstances that include delay or cancellation of flights. The Company will cover the expenses of accommodations and food in the departing location until the arrangement of flights is done. However, the Company holds every right to reroute the original trip or transports which will be in favor of the situation without any addition in the cost. Please note that the company will not be responsible for any missed international flights, losses caused by Altitude Sickness, or any other unpredictable circumstances, and the participants will have to pay all the charges incurred. Nonetheless, the Company will connect and assist you to make the necessary alternative arrangements, but, the additional charge will be covered by the customers themselves.

Regardless of stating every condition and information about the trips on the website and brochures of the Company, we will not be responsible for the unforeseeable situations that may arise before or during the trips. The Company will, however, try its level best to give prior notice about it and take alternate strategies to deal with it. These booking conditions may only be waived in special circumstances, and in writing, by a letter from the Chief of the Company. Note that all the legal agreements set up and signed between the client and the Company shall be subjected to and governed by the Nepalese law.

Note: All the Terms and Conditions mentioned are prepared as per the laws of the Government of Nepal and is governed by them. Therefore, only the head of the Company gets to intervene and holds the authority to make any amendments.

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
