Trip Overview

Trekking to Gurja Himal provides a magnificent view and the trails join with the Rara Dolpo trek route also, Few tourists have been visiting the Gurja Himal trekking trail. The trek passes through the Gurjand beautiful Dhaula valley, tucked away beneath the snowy peaks of the Dhaulagiri range. As a result, the hidden village is an undiscovered gem. You will be able to experience well-beaten routes while meeting local people, and your expenditure will benefit.

Seeing Mount Dhaulagiri, the seventh-highest mountain in the world (8172 m), is a highlight of the Gurja Himal walk. Mountain ranges of Churen Himal (7371 m), Gurja Himal (7193 m), and Dhaulagiri (8172 m). The majority of the "Bishwakarma" residents of the village of Chhantyal depend on farming and herding for their livelihood. There is training in traditional blacksmithing techniques. Their males wore heavy wool jackets that were felted to make them waterproof and were made by women. They climb up to 5,000 meters with their herds in the summer.

They relocate to temporary homes in the lower valley Dhaula during the winter when snow covers the settlement. The slates on one roof touch the roof of the house across from it since the houses are so close to one another. The village is a labyrinth of little lanes. Older residences are adorned with the beautifully carved wooden windows made famous by Gurja Khani artisans.

Background

The most ideal round route for the Hidden Valley variant of Route One is Gurja Himal Trek with Dhorpatan Village. It makes its way back from Gurja Himal over the breathtaking Dhorpatan 3 passes. At Rugachaur Pass, a local trekking guide is essential (3850m). This journey includes Tibetan towns, alpine vistas, traditional villages, panoramic views of the Dhaulagiri Himal and Annapurna peaks, and the Bonpo Monastery. Places to stay and eat locally are teashops and homestays.

Day-to-day-Itinerary

Day 1: Kathmandu - Beni

After arriving in Nepal, depart towards Beni. Beni is 273 kilometers away from Kathmandu, and traveling that distance by bus or jeep will take you 8 to 9 hours. You will drive through picturesque valleys, little towns, and terraced farms on the way. When you get to Beni, you can recover and get ready for the upcoming hike.

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Day 2: Beni - Darbang - trek to Dharapani

Drive to Darbang, which will take around an hour, after breakfast. Start your 2.5-hour hike from Darbang to Dharapani, which is located at an elevation of 1565m. Beautiful villages, farmland, and woodlands are everywhere along the trail. Teahouse accommodation for the night in Dharapani.

Day 3: Trek to Lulang

Start your 6-7 hour hike toward Lulang, which is at an elevation of 2450 meters. The walk offers breathtaking views of the surrounding mountains as it winds through lovely woodlands and across streams. Teahouse accommodation for the night in Lulang.

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Day 4: Trek to Gurja Khani via Gurja Pass

Begin your 8-hour, 2650-meter-high, and in the direction of Gurja Khani hike. Gurja Pass, at a height of 3255 meters, on the trail provides breathtaking views of the mountains nearby. Teahouse accommodation for the night in Gurja Khani

Destination: (Average 8hours)	Accommodation Luxury Lodge in Gurja Khani	Altitude: (2650m) / (3255m)
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Day 5: Extra day in Hidden Village. Side trip to base of Gurja Himal

Spend an additional day at Hidden Village to tour the neighborhood. Take a side excursion, which will take you 5-6 hours, to Gurja Himal's base. Teahouse overnight stay in Hidden Village

Destination: Average 5-6 Hours trekking)	Accommodation Luxury Lodge in Hidden village
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Day 6: Trek to Gurja Ghat/Dhorpatan via Rugachaur Pass

Start your 8 to 9-hour hike toward Gurja Ghat/Dhorpatan, which is at an elevation of 3000m. The trail crosses the 3850m-high Rugachaur Pass, which provides breathtaking views of the mountains nearby. Teahouse accommodation for the night at Gurja Ghat or Dhorpatan

Destination: (Average 8-9 hours trekking)	Accommodation Luxury Lodge in Gurja Ghat	Altitude: (3000m) / (3850m)
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Day 7: Side trip to Tibetan Bonpo Monastery at Chentung (optional).

See the Tibetan Bonpo Monastery in Chentung as a side excursion; it takes around 3-4 hours. Learn

about the Bonpo religion and culture while exploring the monastery. Teahouse accommodation for the night at Gurja Ghat or Dhorpatan

Day 8: Trek to Lumsung via Jaljalla Pass

Start your 6-7 hour hike toward Lumsung, which is at an elevation of 2190 meters. The Jaljalla Pass, which is at a high altitude of 3400 meters and provides breathtaking views of the surrounding mountain, is traversed by the trail. Teahouse stay the night in Lumsung.

Destination: (Average 6-7 hours trekking)	Accommodation Luxury Lodge in Lumsung	Altitude: (2190m) / (3400m)
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Day 9: Trek to Darbang

Start your 6- to 7-hour hike in the direction of Darbang. Beautiful villages, farmland, and woodlands are everywhere along the trail. Teahouse accommodation for the night in Darbang.

Destination: (Average 6-7 hours trekking)	Accommodation Luxury Lodge in Darbang
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Day 10: Back to Pokhara.

It takes about 7-8 hours to drive back to Pokhara. You can take in the picturesque grandeur of the nearby mountains and valleys while traveling. When you arrive in Pokhara, you can unwind and take your time looking. Spend the night in a hotel in Pokhara.
