Luxury Upper Mustang Trek Itinerary

Day 1: Fly to Pokhara from Kathmandu - City Tour

Your **Luxury Upper Mustang Trek itinerary** begins with a short and scenic flight from Kathmandu to Pokhara. Early in the morning, a representative from **Nepal Alternative Treks** will pick you up from your hotel and drop you off at Kathmandu's domestic airport. A stunning aerial view of green hills, winding rivers, and snow-capped peaks in the distance through your window seat makes your flight remarkable. It takes **25 minutes** to get to Pokhara from Kathmandu.

Upon arrival in Pokhara, you'll meet your guide, who'll escort you to your hotel. After checking into your hotel, freshen up and get ready to explore Pokhara city. You'll explore the city in a private vehicle with the assistance of our knowledgeable guide. The visit starts from **World Peak Pagoda**, then to **Devi's Fall**, and **Pumdikot Shiva Statue**. Afterward, you'll explore Pokhara International Museum, and the day concludes with boating at Fewa Lake. You'll stay overnight and have dinner at Fishtail Lodge or a 5-star

category hotel in Pokhara.

Day 2: Fly to Jomsom from Pokhara - Trek to Kagbeni via Lubra Village

Day two starts with a drive to the airport for a thrilling flight to Jomsom from Pokhara. The flight takes only **20 minutes**, but the experience and view you'll gain are unforgettable. Flying above the **Kali Gandaki Gorge**, between the mountain peaks of Dhaulagiri and Annapurna, offers a visually appealing view before landing at *Jomsom*. As you land, you'll feel the shift in landscape from the lush green of Pokhara to the arid windswept terrain of the trans-Himalayan region.

After resting for a while and having breakfast, you'll start your **Luxury Upper Mustang Trek journey** with the assistance of our guide. The trek begins by crossing the **Kaligandaki River**, following the route that slowly ascends to Lubra village. The village is one of the last remaining **Bon villages** in the Mustang region. After getting to *Lubra*, you can take a moment to appreciate the village's calmness and unspoiled beauty.

After exploring the village, you'll continue trekking downhill to join the main section to **Kagbeni**. In the village, you'll settle in Red House Lodge for your accommodation and the meal of the day.

Day 3: Trek to Chele

With the freshness of the Himalayas, you'll wake up, get freshened up, and enjoy your breakfast. Today, you begin your journey into the *restricted Upper Mustang region* from *Kagbeni to Chele*. After breakfast at Kagbeni, you'll complete the special permit check at the checkpoints and continue your day's trek. The trek begins with a dry and rugged section along the Kali Gandaki River. The route offers views of eroded cliffs, barren canyons, and the unique landscape of Mustang.

Along the way, you'll pass through **Tangbe**, a beautiful village with narrow alleyways, apple orchards, buckwheat fields, and chortens. The trek then continues toward Chhusang. From there, you'll cross a small bridge and ascend steeply through a narrow canyon to reach Chele. Upon getting to the village, you'll check into the Hotel Mustang Gate or a similar category. Chale marks the official entry into the culturally Tibetan region of Upper Mustang. Your night's stay and dinner are at the accommodation point in Chele.

Day 4: Trek to Syangboche

You'll depart from Chele after having a hearty morning meal at the accommodation point where you've spent the last night. Leaving Chele, you'll continue your **Luxury Upper Mustang Trek route** ascending through steep, rocky pathways and narrow gorges. The first significant climb leads to the *Taklam La Pass (3,624 meters)*, offering sweeping views of the Nilgiri and Tilicho peaks.

As you continue, you'll descend into Samar village, surrounded by poplar trees and barley fields. At the village, you'll take a rest for a while and have lunch. From Somar, the trek continues through a quiet canyon, eventually reaching **Bhena** and then the **Yamda La Pass (3,850 meters)**. Reaching there, you'll notice a change in the landscape with more chortens, caves, and a view of sculpted cliffs.

The final section to Syangboche is a gentle climb and descent. Reaching there, you'll check into Hotel Nilgiri or a similar category. You'll stay overnight and have dinner at the accommodation point you check into on the day.

Day 5: Trek to Ghami

Day five takes you deeper into the stunning landscape of **Upper Mustang**. The day's **Luxury Trek to Upper Mustang** starts after breakfast at Syagboche. The trek begins by slowly ascending through barren hills alongside the copper-red canyon. After a steady climb, you'll reach the **Nyi La Pass (4,010 meters)**, one of the highest points of the trek. From the top of the pass, you can see the astonishing views of Mustang Valley and Himalayan peaks like Nilgiri and Annapurna.

From Nyi La, you'll descend along a rocky path to reach Gheling village, where you'll take a rest and have a hearty lunch. After lunch, the trek continues over another small pass, *Ghami La (3,765 meters)*. From the pass, you'll descend into the village of Ghami. Your day's overnight stay and dinner will be at Hotel Royal Mustang at Ghami.

Day 6: Trek to Tsarang

Day six of the **Upper Mustang Luxury Trip** takes you closer to your final destination. After breakfast at Ghami, you'll continue your trek towards Tsarang. The trek begins by crossing a suspension bridge over *Ghami Khola*, following the route uphill towards Dhakmar. Along the way, you'll pass the longest mani wall in Mustang.

As you trek higher, the landscape transforms, with a bright red cliff on your left marking the location of Dhakmar village. According to legend, the Red Cliff is stained with the blood of a demon defeated by **Guru Rinpoche**. Similarly, it is a mystical village surrounded by crimson-hued rock formations. On the day, you'll stay overnight and have supper at Maya's Heritage Inn at Tsarang.

Day 7: Trek to Lo Manthang via Marang La Pass

Day seven takes you to your ultimate destination, Lo Manthang, on the **Luxury Upper Mustang Trekking route**. As usual, you'll start your day with a warm cup of tea and a hearty breakfast. After breakfast, you'll leave Tsarang behind, walking past fields, mani walls, and white chortens. From the walkway, the route takes you toward the **Marang La Pass (4,280 m)**, offering panoramic views of the entire Mustang region. Marang La is the final high pass before you descend into the walled capital of the ancient kingdom of Mustang.

From the top of the Marang La, you'll catch a first view of Lo Manthang village, a treeless settlement, backed by the snow-capped peaks of Tibet. Descending slowly from the pass, you'll reach Lo Manthang. Stepping there feels like walking through ancient times, providing a sense of accomplishment. Your overnight stay and dinner will be at Shinta Mani Hotel or Royal Mustang Hotel in Lo Manthang.

Day 8: Full day exploration

Day eight is all yours, as it is your exploration day to the Walled City of Lo Manthang. Our knowledgeable guide, who has guided thousands of travellers worldwide in the valley, will guide you, offering insightful knowledge. You'll start your day by wandering the narrow alleys of Lo Manthang, where you'll see local people in traditional attire. On the day, you'll explore the **Royal Palace**, a residence where the Mustang kings used to live.

Similarly, you'll explore *Jampa Lhakhang*, also known as "**God House**", a 15th-century monastery which is home to a massive clay statue of Buddha. Likewise, *Thubchen Gompa* is another visiting point in Lo

Manthang. Along with the locations, Chhoede Monastery, the main monastic center of Lo Manthang, where you may witness rituals, prayer sessions, or even traditional debates, is another point of exploration. Tingkhar village is also an option, but visiting there is optional. After a full day of exploration, you'll return to your accommodation point from yesterday for the day's overnight stay.

Day 9: Fly to Kathmandu by Helicopter

Outside the helipad, our representative will be waiting for you to pick you up and drop you off at your accommodation point. You can explore the vibrant city of Kathmandu for the remaining time and experience the nightlife of Thamel on your own. The day's overnight stay and dinner will be at Kathmandu on your own.

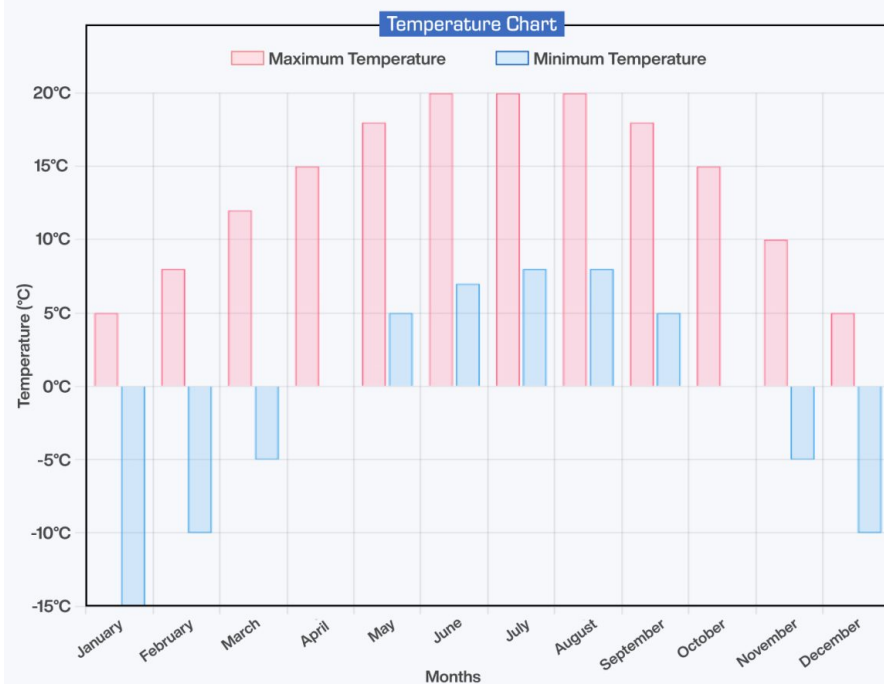
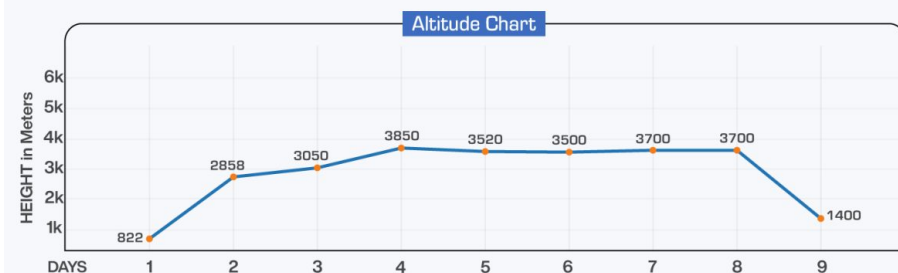
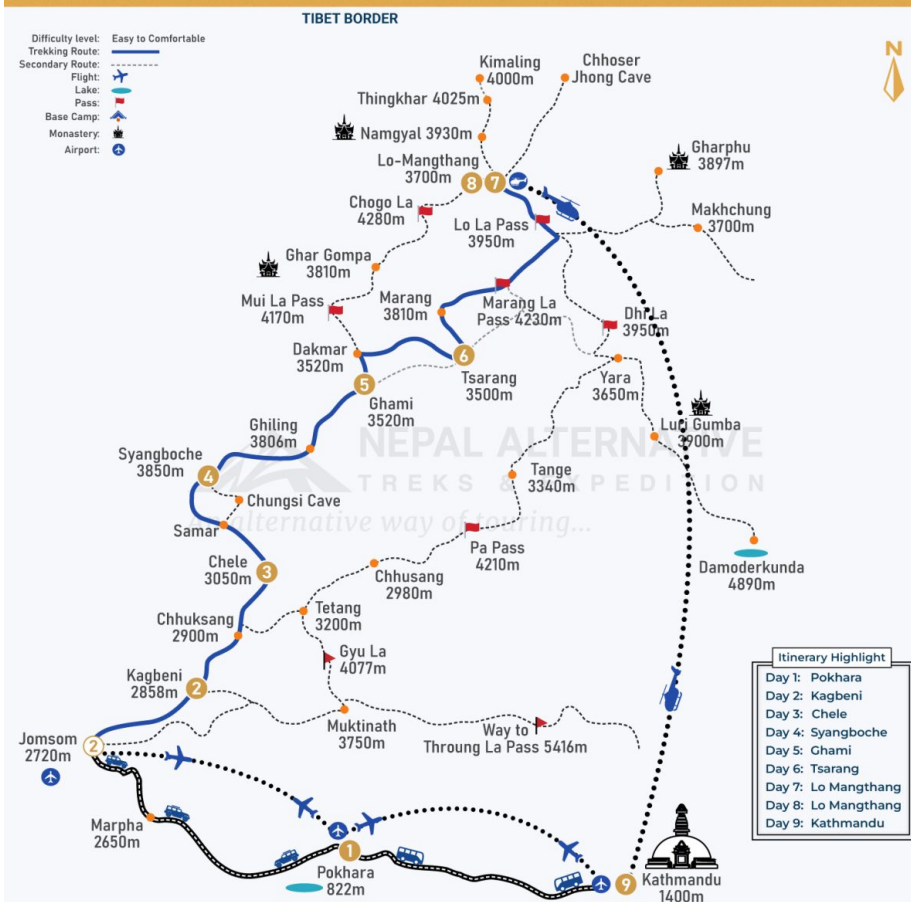

How physically demanding is the luxury Upper Mustang trek?

The Upper Mustang Luxury Trek is considered moderately demanding and requires a good level of physical fitness. Although it is a luxury trek, the part of the route from Kagbeji to Lo Manthan is physically demanding, where you must walk. The high altitude, the rocky and barren terrain, and the remote location make the trek quite demanding.

Is the luxury version suitable for older travelers or families?

Yes, the Luxury version of Upper Mustang is suitable for older travelers or families. In fact, it is a perfect option for those with families, particularly those seeking comfort, convenience, and unique experiences. However, it is recommended to consult with your doctors before starting the trek with your family.

What kind of food can I expect on a luxury trek in Mustang?

On a luxury trek in Mustang, you can expect a mix of authentic local cuisine and comfort meals. The locals prepare the meals with better ingredients, cleaner kitchen practices, and more variety than on standard teahouse treks. Additionally, if you have any dietary preferences, please inform us in advance.

Are there private bathrooms available throughout the Luxury Mustang Trek?

Yes, private bathrooms are available throughout the trek to Luxury Mustang Trek, as your itinerary is designed with premium lodges and 5-star accommodations. The bathroom features a Western toilet, a hot shower, and other essential amenities.

What should I pack differently for a luxury trek?

For a luxury trek, your packing list will differ slightly from a standard trek because some amenities are already provided, and the comfort level is higher. Thus, you can upgrade your style on the luxury Upper Mustang trip. However, basic items like hiking boots, layered clothing, sun protection, a daypack, and personal medications stay the same even in a luxury trek.

Cancellation Policy

We understand that plans can change willy-nilly. However it is our responsibility to ensure fairness and transparency among our customers regarding our cancellation policy. So we kindly request all travelers to carefully review the cancellation and refund policy before confirming their trip.

After your trip starts, we cannot provide a refund for any voluntary withdrawal, cancellation, or early departure by the traveler. This means ***the full amount paid to us will not be refunded after the trip has begun.*** Likewise, if during the trip, any services such as accommodation, sightseeing, meals, transportation, etc. included in the itinerary/trip are not used by the customer, no refunds or reuse will be provided to whatever portion remains unused on the trip.

Also, please note that ***last-minute cancellations are non-refundable.*** You have to understand that many trip arrangements such as accommodation, transportation, permits, guides, and operational logistics are confirmed and pre-booked. Thus, cancellations made at the last minute create non-

recoverable costs for the company and so do for our clients. In addition, cancellations made shortly before the departure date or after the trip has started will be considered as last-minute cancellations and will not be eligible for any refund.

Still, the company will use their discretion in setting the conditions for the refunds, therefore, few of the conditions mentioned are subject to change. The company holds every right to cancel the trips booked by the customers before it is guaranteed to run or an official agreement is signed. A trip is guaranteed to run once it has two fully paid travelers unless minimum numbers state otherwise.

Unfortunate circumstances such as unforeseen natural disaster, canceled flights, strike, industrial action, wars, riots, quarantine, government intervention, weather, the deteriorating health condition of a group member, etc. could lead to cancellation of trips. In such cases, the customer can either ask to get back the 90% of the total trip cost paid to the company (13% Government Tax will be deducted) or reuse the cost in an alternative trip with the same price, immediately, in the following season of the same year.

The company will require a written notice in case of any cancellation. Please ensure the date of the trip cancellation is the date on which the written cancellation is received by the company. If you cancel the trip anytime prior to the departure date of the actual trip, 90% of the total cost is reusable for a year or refund.

Trip Amendment

First and foremost, please note that all the amendment conditions are applied to the trips listed on this site only. Below are a few notes to take about the amendment fees in case of any changes during, while, or after the booking:

If the company receives a request on the booking amendments at least 60 days prior to the trip, a total of USD 50/person is charged to the customer. However, if the customer's request for a booking amendment in less than 60 days before the trip departure, then the charges will be as per the cancellation policy mentioned above. In case of any changes in the price of the trip during the procedure of booking and the amendments, the new cost will be applied to the trips. Please note that these changes might not be applied by the company, but can be levied upon the company by the third parties i.e. the hotels or the service providers working with the company.

Any changes, amendments, or additions in aggregation to the trips you have booked, for example, hotels, transfers, additional days, etc. will account for no additional fee.

Health Conditions

Nepal Alternative Treks places the highest priority on the safety and well-being of all travelers. We need to ensure the traveler's well-being and health condition at the time of booking. While travelers can participate without medical documentation, those with chronic illnesses or long-term medical conditions must obtain a doctor's consent before joining the trip. This is to ensure their health is not badly affected during the adventure and that they can safely enjoy the journey.

The company will not be responsible for any type of mishaps and will not bear the medical and evacuation expenses on behalf of the participant. Therefore, we request our clients to consult their doctors for a thorough checkup and vaccination before booking a trip with us. In addition, clients with specific health needs or concerns should inform the Company in advance. This allows us to provide guidance and, if

required, arrange additional services to make the trip safer and more comfortable. If needed, clients may also request additional services related to the length of the trip or stay in the country of travel.

Weather and other unfavorable conditions

Clients should be well aware of the unpredictability of the weather conditions in the mountainous regions. The unfortunate weather conditions, especially in the Everest, Jomsom, and Kanchenjunga regions, can sometimes lead to unfavorable circumstances that include delay or cancellation of flights. The Company will cover the expenses of accommodations and food in the departing location until the arrangement of flights is done. However, the Company holds every right to reroute the original trip or transports which will be in favor of the situation without any addition in the cost. Please note that the company will not be responsible for any missed international flights, losses caused by Altitude Sickness, or any other unpredictable circumstances, and the participants will have to pay all the charges incurred. Nonetheless, the Company will connect and assist you to make the necessary alternative arrangements, but, the additional charge will be covered by the customers themselves.

Regardless of stating every condition and information about the trips on the website and brochures of the Company, we will not be responsible for the unforeseeable situations that may arise before or during the trips. The Company will, however, try its level best to give prior notice about it and take alternate strategies to deal with it. These booking conditions may only be waived in special circumstances, and in writing, by a letter from the Chief of the Company. Note that all the legal agreements set up and signed between the client and the Company shall be subjected to and governed by the Nepalese law.

Note: All the Terms and Conditions mentioned are prepared as per the laws of the Government of Nepal and is governed by them. Therefore, only the head of the Company gets to intervene and holds the authority to make any amendments.
